

Tournament Rules

General Guidelines:

- All teams are guaranteed two games.
- Please have your team ready to play, at their assigned court, at least five minutes prior to their starting time.
- Medals will be awarded to all first, second, and consolation place teams
- Team rosters can consist of up to four players. All teams must start the first round of tournament play with three players. If a player is injured, teams may elect to play with less than three players on the court.
- Players may only play on one team.
- Boys 7 year old divisions and all Girls divisions will use a Women's size ball.

Game Rules:

- Loser's Outs.
- Games will be 10 minutes, running time. The clock will stop for injuries and at the discretion of the official or timekeeper.
- A coin flip will determine which team is awarded the initial possession, then alternating possession will go into effect on jump balls.
- Two points will be awarded for each basket.
- Three points will be awarded for each three-point basket.
- All defensive rebounds must be cleared past the free-throw line extended, including airballs.
- All dead balls are taken out of bounds at the top.
- Substitutions can be made on any dead ball.
- There are no time-outs.
- The offensive team must pass the ball into play within five seconds or it is a turnover.
- Fouls will result in the ball being given to the team that was fouled.
- Teams will get one point plus possession of the ball when their player is fouled on a missed shot.
- Teams will be awarded the basket plus possession of the ball when their player is fouled on a made shot.
- There are no player disqualifications. However, after 5 team fouls, the team that was fouled will get 2 points plus possession.
- In the event of a tie, there will be a two minute overtime. If the game is still tied, there will be a sudden death overtime. The first team to score two points will win the game.
- Alternate possession rule will continue in all overtime periods.
- All overtime periods will follow the rules for the last two minutes of regulation.
- Any other interpretations or rule judgments will be decided by the rules committee
